State Attorney Aronberg Announces Opening Ceremony of National Crime Victims' Rights Week

State Attorney Dave Aronberg will be a guest speaker on Monday, April 22, 2024, at the first of a series of local observances for National Crime Victims' Rights Week.

The opening ceremony will held from 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. at the Palm Beach County Police Benevolent Association, 2100 N. Florida Mango Road, West Palm Beach.
